Reason is that Nor.Pac. & all other opponents are industriously circulating reports that we never intended to build the Pembina end, as it would destroy our steamboat lines.

Mr. Farley is of opinion that the court wouldbe slow to order the lease to a line that was without any rolling stock. Our object for making this lease is an important one & will be explained to you by Mr. Stephens. Of course, if the Railway from Breckenridge to Fisher's Landing and the steamboats were one interest there is no doubt but it would be mutually be ficial."
