were not aware of his building between Anoka and Glenwood. I have written Sir George today ... Later experience is showing that the line to the Sault will be of very little value for through business, and it is only from through business that the Canadian Pacific would derive any benefit. I think Washburn and his friends consider the Sault enterprise likely to prove an unprofitab undertaking. It would

seem unfortunate that our Montreal friends should have affiliatid with the only people who are giving us trouble in Minnesota."
