To A. R. Ledoux, New York City We should not have bought the Spokane Falls and Northern except in the adjustment of a territorial question. It is capitalized beyond its value. An English co. is building from Kootenai Lake to Bonner's Ferry, which will be a shorter line both as to time & distance. Same parties own the Kaslo & Slocan narrow gauge. Canadian Pacific is also building a line in, known as the Crows Nest Pass line, which will parallel the Canadian extension of the Spokane s & Northern.
