Hill was secretary of the association, which ran the driving club and state fair on its property in St. Paul. It was a stock co. with \$50,000 shares. Horse racing was apparently the main interest. The journal (1872-78) contains, among other data, a list of stockholders. The ledger covers the years from 1872-1876. The Driving Club record book, 1872-76, lists the entries in races by horses' names, owners, enterers, color, rider, and pedigree. The Assoc. evidently failed about 1878 and presumably either went out of existence or had a new secretary who did not get the earlier records from Hill.
