Other topics to watch are: St. Paul Seminary; education costs of his sons; donations to his children, etc. In fact, much of Hill's financial activities and status be found in these pages, which are merely press copies of doc-

uments(some typed, some in handwriting), to be found filed elsewhere much scattered, in his papers. Here they a indexed in every volume, and are more or less in chronological order.
