Galt has what to us here seems an absurd idea that he can ship his [Bell River?] . . . coal to Benton where he says there is a large market for good coal such as he claims his coal to be. Lave definitely told his that the CPR could not rmit any charter to be given for any line running from the CPR south

I explained our position on him & he seemed bo be satisfied with what I said as to that territory being better served by the extension of the Manitoba Road which I went so far as to say could be a matter of no distant day" and advising him to get in touch with you, rather than dickering with Galt.
