In Nor. Pac. agreement we have agreed to submit all matters of difference in re running arrangements, division of revenues, & rates to be charged on Bismarck, Moorhead & Fargo business. Tomorrow we take up matter of contracts for the Extension work & lease of that line. We have attached Darwin Litchfield's stock in First Div. Co. & all his lands &c in this state. I hope Canadian Government will not fail to finish their road [to boundary] this year to connect with ours. Re removal of Trustees of \$15 million mortgage "so that there will be no reason for failure to ~~that~~ decree of foreclos-

ure in December. Cross are splendid.
