Thompson has done nothing with Bigelow & thinks Bigelow knows nothing of Litchfield's ideas outside of the lawsuit. Bigelow's casual meeting with Hill & remarks about Litchfield. Hill thinks of approaching Litchfield himself [re purchase of his stock?] Main Line is furnishing more than its share of rolling stock. Branch Line hasn't enough passenger cars to do its Minneapolis and St. Paul business alone. Terrible last week between the State fair & the Presidential party.
