

Stephen, George and Associates 1878-1883

A series of "Statements of Account" of Hill with J.S. Kennedy & Co., N.Y., revealing the manner of financing the two syndicates, Geo. Stephen Associates and Canadian Pacific Syndicate parallel Kennedy's letter to Hill in this period. The dates follow: Jany.22, Feb.25, March 9, April 12,15, May 10, 11, 25, June 21, July 2, 10, 15,21, Aug. 17, 1880; Feb. 17, April 30, June 10, Oct. 12, Oct. 13, 1881; March 29, April 28, Sept. 1, Nov.16, Dec. 30,1882; Jany. 27, Feb.16,26, Apr. 6,19,23,27, May 23, June 26, July 28, Aug. 8, Oct. 17, Nov.17,30, 1883. A. Smith, George Stephen, Norman W. Kittson, R. B. Angus, etc. Kennedy carried the accounts of all three roads, issued bonds, did their investing, reported on their mortgages, bonds, stocks, &c., and also carried Hill's individual account. The statements have been filed under the dates of rendering, but they usually begin earlier. Under date of May 10, 1880, is filed one report entitled, "Memorandum of Cash Transactions including Analysis of George Stephen and Associates account with J. S. Kennedy Co. New York From 28th Feb. 1878 to 10th May 1880." Another, filed under date of Aug. 17, 1880, includes "Statement of cash and bonds due Amsterdam Committee in their settlement with George Stephen & Associates," Memorandum of payments under

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
