

Stephen, George (First Baron Mount Stephen)
1829-1921.

In 1888 Stephen retired from the presidency of the Canadian Pacific R.R. and in 1893 made his home in England. He was created a baronet in 1886, and a peer in 1891. He lived chiefly at Bocket Hall, Hertfordshire. He left the residue of his estate to King Edward's Hospital Fund. He died at Bocket Hall, Nov. 29, 1921. There were no children of ~~of~~ either of his two marriages, but he left an adopted daughter, who married Henry Stafford Northcote, Baron Northcote.
