"I remember that while the Red River Transportation Company was operating the line to Winnipeg that you were paid annually a salary. The matter of a salary from the Canadian Pacific will, as you must readily see, have to be settled by officers of that Company. Your long connection with the Canadian Northwest and the continued efforts you have made in its behalf many times at the expense of your own country, should I think have secured you better returns."
