A good description of building this railroad is contained in letter from Hamilton Browne to Hill, April 21, 1880.

See also clipping attached to Browne to Hill, July 24, 1880 which states:

"The Toledo & Northwestern Railway is reaching out for the Dakota and Black Hills trade, and is fast becoming one of the leading roads of the West. Last fall at the organization of the new company and first election of officers, there were but three miles

of road in operation, but at the annual meeting in September there will be nearly, if not quite a hundred miles completed."
