Hill to Gov. Toole, Helena, Montana

Some weeks since Messrs. Foley Bros. and Guthrie railroad contractors, who have been building railways in Montana for this company for the past two years took a contract for some work in Butte and moved on to this work with a large body of men and teams. A mob attacked them and warned that unless their rate of wages increased from \$2 to \$3 a day they would not be allowed to continue. Asks aid. A.Guthrie will present this letter.
