"Mr. Mead has been informed that the Hon. James Wadsworth, chairman of the Congressional Committee on Agriculture would be much influenced by anything you say on the subject [irrigation] and if you think best to write him a letter suggesting an increase of \$30,000 in the appropriation for 'Irrigation and Drainage Investigations' to permit carrying out the work of Congressmen Brooks and Mondell, that Mr. Wadsworth would probably favor this action and it might go through."
