Re source of money for U.S. irrigation expenditures, i.e., sale of public lands under 3 laws now proposed to be repealed: desert land, timber and stone, and commuted homestead. H. goes into details re workings of these acts & does not favor repeal. Suggests an amendment he will introduce next Congress session to desert land act.
