Van Horne to J.J.Hill.

Refers to Hill's letter of Nov. 26th enclosing a letter from Arnoldi. States "the concern he [Arnoldi] refers to seems to be hopelessly involved in litigation which is likely to take years to straighten out."

Also refers to Greenway and states, "We have no recent information as to what is going on inside, but Greenway has just had a back set in a bye election in Manitoba in which his railway scheme was the chief question at issue, and this is likely to have a good deal

of effect with some of his colleagues."
