Vouchers

Hill's vouchers are in two series: those to 1896, numbered rather erratically by date of month and year; and those beginning in 1896 with Number 1 and continuing consecutively until his death in 1916. There is much correspondence attached to vouchers -- glued on by clerks in his office and so, perforce, left with the vouchers instead of being filed with General Correspondence. However, the larger part consists of carbon copies of letters and documents by J.J. Toomey or other clerks and private secretaries, for which other copies may be found in the Hil collection.
