

World War I - American sentiment 1915

In the summer and early fall of 1915 there is much correspondence between Hill, Lord Reading, J.P.Morgan, Gaspard Farrer, and others about a U.S. loan to the Allies. One pencilled draft of a telegram to Morgan, Sept. 29, 1915, in Hill's own handwriting has been framed by someone. Lord Reading's letter to Hill of October 15, 1915, shows that Hill played a leading role in inaugurating the loan [Liberty Loan].
