"I have arranged the Wright & Davis matter, paying them Two million dollars, cash; \$750,000 to be paid in May next when the Railway is turned over; and \$250,000 October first next when the present years logging business is closed and the logging contract turned over to us. We have at their request allowed \$1,000,000 to run at three and one-half per cent interest until August next. If we pay Four per cent, which seems right, to the Bank and Mr. Kennedy, the commission should not exceed one-half of one per cent."
