

Family Papers                      Stack II, Tiers 1 and 2

These are the files of letters &c. that passed between L. S. Hill, Sr., and his father and mother brothers and sisters, wife and children, and some other relatives. They begin with 1900 (few until 1916, when J.J.Hill died) and continue until shortly after his death in 1948. Most of the inward letters are handwritten. The outward letters, i.e., Hill's or his secretary's, begin when he commenced to file them in his office, i.e., after his father's death in 1916 or thereabout. His correspondence before that time was evidently filed elsewhere, probably in his home. This

"Home File, or what has been added to the office files by his children, mostly since 1960, has been kept quite separate from Family Papers as was requested when the Home File was presented to the Hill Family Foundation, now owners of the L.W. Hill and family papers.

The Home File is located in Stack VII, Tier 1. It begins in 1887 and continues beyond Hill's death into the early 1950's. It is much more than family correspondence, but is strictly personal. It fills eleven boxes.
