Much information on the business end of the
park, especially the operations of the Glacier
Park Hotel Company; the Noffsinger family
Wilbur N. (d. 1924) and his son G.W., who carried

on the business of the Pack Saddle Horse Co.,
who worked for L.W.Hill: at least through 1932
(see additional data on this family in Hill's
oil papers for these years); building of hotel
at Waterton Lakes, ^{park} Alberta, in 1926-7; Prince of
Wales Hotel there; Stephen Mather's strange con-
duct in re the sawmill destruction in Glacier
Park, 1926; Blackfoot Indians; etc.
