L.W. Hill writing to his wife: "The family have all been so busy emptying the house of rug furniture and pictures....[I] got the Puvis de Chavannes [painting] from the upstairs sitting room ... [and] the big Delacroix - "The Streets of Tangier." See also May 10, 1923: "It is pathetic that brothers and sisters should act as that crowd did."
