She moved with her parents to St. Paul in 1888 and lived there the rest of her life except for many early trips elsewhere in the 1890's, and as a nurse in a N.Y. hospital just prior to her marriage to L.W.Hill, Sr., on June 5 1901. Her papers are full of letters by herself and her family (particularly her mother) and many friends and admirers. A close friend was Lillia Stephenson Emerson. Other frequent correspondents were: Maria Banks Taylor, Jos. Howland Hunt, Lyman Colt, Dr. Kenelm Winslow, Almeric Paget (Lord Queenborough), her sisters, brother Harry, etc. Colt and Harry wrote from Alaska in goldrush day and later, Hunt as an architect from Harvard and later from Paris.
