

PERSONAL PAPERS (of Louis W. Hill) Stacks I-III

These are:

- (1) L.W.Hill's office files of non-business letters, both originals received and copies sent (other copies than these carbons are often to be found in the Letterpress Vols., q.v.), boxes 1-175. This file does not include correspondence for railroad, banking, oil, timber, lands mining, father's & mother's estates, North Oaks Farm matters, &c, for which see their own files.
- (2) FAMILY PAPERS 18 boxes, letters sent (carbons mostly) & rec'd by Hill, from 1900 to his death. Filed in his office, apparently because he dictated his replies there, when they were not made and signed by his office staff.

Members of his family usually wrote longhand letters; he replied with typewritten ones.

a. vols. marked "150" to "180", a file continued by Toomey after J.J.H.'s death in 1916 (vols. 1-149 are now in J.J.H.'s papers in the Hill Reference Library.

b. loose papers, 31 boxes, 1916-1922: carbon mostly (often duplicated in (4) above.)
