Writes re his work among Indians of West. Began in 1909. Offers his "200 portraits, scenes of historic sites and battlefields (24) large & small as well as my entire collection of Indian stuff, of which I have some fine specimens." Lists are included: Crows (16 portraits including 'Curley' (2) scout & "only survivor of the Battle June 25, 1876"; "Goes Ahead, Chief Plenty Coups chief Two Leggings & many of the old fighters." Arikaras including Little Crow and White Bear; Nez Perces (7) Chief Te-To-Ho-Note Two Moons; Okinagans (4); Cheyennes (17); Gros Ventres (9)
