

Toomey, John J. - Memorandum of Nov.26,1921

read at meeting of the heirs immediately after Mary T. Hill's death. It lists the gifts that Mrs. Hill had told him she wished to make: for a hospital for incurables, \$400,000; for a James J. Hill Memorial or Art Museum to the city of St. Paul, \$3,000,000, with details of all the paintings owned by Mrs. Hill and other art objects in her homes; for 240 Summit, her St. Paul residence, to the the free residence of her daughter Mrs. Egil Boeckmann and her husband for 6 years and then to go, land and bldg. to the city of St. Paul; \$500,000 to James J.

Hill Reference Library ; \$96,000 to Charlotte Slade and \$45,000 to Daniel "in addition to regular allowances." Also lists of the securities in Mrs. Hill's possession just before her death.
