

Tuck, Mrs. Edward (Julia Stell) - Death

Portrait and sketch of her activities and philanthropies -- also honors from France, &c. Also data on her husband, son of Amos Tuck, for whom he established the Amos Tuck School of Administration at Dartmouth College. In 1865 he was made American Vice Consul at Paris -- 1871 became a member of intern'l banking firm of Munroe & Co., from which he retired in 1881. The Tucks gave their art collection worth 3 million francs to city of Paris; before World War I they gave a hospital at Reuil. In 1926 gave to French nation Empress Josephine mansion adjoining

over

Malmaison. Booklet lists French honors to him.  
She established Stella Hospital in 1903, also  
l'École Ménagère for working-men's daughters.
