SCOPE AND CONTENTS

Files documenting substantive or precedent setting cases regarding public health matters, particularly the fight over fluoridation of Brainerd's municipal water supply, the state's contract with Environmental Aviation Services, Inc. to spray insecticide in various locations, and hazardous chemical clean-up at the Reilly Tar and Chemical Corporation's St. Louis Park site. There are also files dealing with nursing home and community health care program operation, licensing, and facilities; licensing of plumbers and ambulance services; abortion rights; and toxic shock syndrome. Most cases were heard in state district courts; some went to the state supreme court.

Included are transcripts of hearings and testimony, depositions, court orders and pleadings, memoranda, correspondence, and other legal instruments.
