Files of Elizabeth Bachmann, Secretary to the Forestry Division Director. Included are correspondence (1942-1944, 1951), including letters from division employees serving in the military during World War II; files relating to a 1956 forestry crossword puzzle and ghost towns (ca. 1950s); and articles for publication (1940-1965). Written primarily by Bachmann for various departmental publications; the latter detail state wildlife, vegetation, and other forestry topics and may contain the article, correspondence with publishers, photographs, and research documents.
