SCOPE AND CONTENTS OF THE RECORDS

Correspondence, memos, reports, legislation, financial records, and related materials documenting all aspects of the department's administration and activities.

Topics for which the files are particularly extensive include chartered schools, computers and technology in schools, health, Educational Cooperative Service Units (ECSUs), employee relations, referendums, reorganization and restructuring, records disposal, permanent school fund, post-secondary enrollment options, AIDS, libraries, math and science, spelling bee, non-public schools, open enrollment, the Martin Luther King holiday, assessment program, teacher licensing and placement, teacher training, superintendents, the China teacher exchange program, equal opportunity, graduation standards, and foreign language, special, compensatory, migrant, environmental, Indian, international, outcome based, and vocational education.
