### SCOPE AND CONTENTS OF THE RECORDS

Annual inventories (1889-1890, 1901-1935) giving (where applicable) number, measure, present value and location, and where used or kept, for all items listed individually and summarized in the following categories: real estate, provisions and groceries, household supplies, clothing, fuel and light, hospital and medical supplies, postage and telephone systems, stationery, library, supplies for instruction and amusement, scientific apparatus, material for manufacturers, farm supplies and livestock, machinery and tools, building materials, and "miscellaneous."

Also inventory summaries (1889-1900) of total dollar amounts classified as follows: food (subdivided), clothing and bedding (subdivided), laundry supplies, medicines and medical supplies, stamps, books and stationery, amusements, and instruction apparatus, household supplies, furniture and carpets, tools and machinery, farm, garden, stock, grounds (subdivided), and industrial training supplies (subdivided); and a record of supplies (ca. 1899-1901).
