SCOPE AND CONTENTS OF THE RECORDS

Includes printed copies and some miscellaneous typescripts for the years 1860-1927 and occasional later years, primarily for holidays and other celebratory occasions, and indexes for the years 1901-1965 and 1977-1978. Of particular interest are proclamations declaring the creation of new or partitioned counties, 1895-1912.

ASSOCIATED MATERIALS

The official copies of proclamations issued prior to 1901 apparently are recorded in Minnesota. Governor. Executive journals. Proclamations files of governors Anderson (1961-1963), Quie (1979-1982), and Perpich (1982-1990) are cataloged separately. Proclamations of several other governors are found among their general records or subject files.
