SCOPE AND CONTENTS OF THE RECORDS

Documenting the occurrence of over eighty diseases, these files cover outbreaks, investigations, prevention programs, and vaccine and other medication distributions and studies. Included are reports, research papers and articles, analyses, case histories, surveys, and statistics. The latter, kept both on cases and deaths, were collected using criteria such as location, date, sex, race, and age.

Note to researchers: Although labeled "communicable disease histories" by the Health Department, these files also cover a number of non-communicable diseases. They also contain information on environmental sanitation, animal diseases, instructions to food handlers, and departmental memos on athlete's feet and pediculosis (head lice).
