Originally Joint Independent Consolidated School District No. 91 of Goodhue, Rice, Dodge, and Steele Counties; became Independent School District No. 254 on September 6, 1957.

Clerk's books (1892-1905); treasurer's books (1898-1919) and registers of receipts and disbursements (1923-1932); various financial records (1937-1975); superintendent's and teacher's reports (1901-1942); athletics department/association records (1916-1948); school board (1892-1898, 1960-1962) and PTA (1924-1945) minutes; and photographs (1923-1960) of classes and of football and baseball teams. There are also assorted manuals, guidebooks, student publications, and programs.
