#### SCOPE AND CONTENTS OF THE RECORDS

Files containing periodic and final reports (some published), budgets, work programs, correspondence and internal memos for projects funded by the LCMR.

The State Planning Agency records cover projects involving aerial photography and remote sensing, copper-nickel mining environmental impact, the Minnesota Land Management Information System, Office of Local and Urban Affairs, recreation grants, and land use planning.

Agency projects documented in the chronological files include those of the state departments of natural resources, health, trade and economic development, and agriculture, the Minnesota Historical Society, University of Minnesota, Science Museum of Minnesota, State University Board, Land Management Information Center, Land and Water Conservation Fund [LAWCON], and state planning, energy, and pollution control agencies. Major topics covered include land and site acquisition and betterment, federal recreation grants, historic sites, aerial photography, watershed management, archaeological and soil surveys, energy, peat, copper and nickel mining, land use, geological research, biomass cash crops, historical records, environmental education, pollution prevention, sustainable development, trails, and habitat conservation.

The semi-annual status reports document the progress of various LCMR projects.

#### ARRANGEMENT OF THE RECORDS

The records are divided into three subsets: State Planning Agency conducted projects, arranged alphabetically by project name; chronological project files listed by enabling legislation (Minn. Laws, Chapter, Section, Subdivision) and agency name; and chronological semi-annual status reports.
