SCOPE AND CONTENTS OF THE RECORDS

Correspondence, reports, work plans, background materials, briefing papers, speeches, and budget records documenting Ditmore's activities as SPA deputy commissioner, Minnesota Environmental Quality Board chair, Minnesota representative on the Council of Great Lakes Governors' Water Management Committee, and Environmental Compact of the States (ECOS) project director. The latter, proposed by Governor Perpich, was an organization of states whose focus would be on environment and natural resources issues facing the states.

Other topics covered in the files include the daily administration of the agency, funding and budgeting, numerous environmental projects and issues, and the agency's relationship with other state and federal agencies, state legislators, and private organizations.

The CGLG's Water Management Committee, 1985-, and its predecessor, the Task Force on Water Divisions and Great Lakes Institutions, 1984-1985, advise the CGLG on all matters relating to the water quality and quantity in the Lakes, particularly water diversion projects, state legislation, toxic pollutants control, and interstate solid waste transport. Of particular interest in these files were the Great Lakes Charter and the Great Lakes Protection Fund. Ditmore served as Minnesota's representative on the task forceand the committee and as chair of the latter from 1988-1989.
