# SCOPE AND CONTENTS OF THE RECORDS

Files documenting the operation and administration of this division, which provided the legal research skills for tax policy formation and assistance to the operating divisions in the application of tax laws. The department's legislative activities were also centered in this division, including development of legislative programs, bill drafting, and presentation of information to legislative committees.

The files consist of the correspondence and subject files of Gregg C. Miller, detailing his activities as assistant commissioner in charge of the division; correspondence files of division attorney Lucy Mitchell, concerning various legal issues relating to the department; income tax rules hearing records; income tax correspondence and interoffice memoranda; and legislative files, mainly concerning various forms of taxation.
