### SCOPE AND CONTENTS OF THE RECORDS

Annual and biennial reports submitted to the governor, the legislature, and the director of the Public Institutions Division of the Social Security Department regarding school conditions and needs of the institution.

Included are descriptions of the school and its facilities; reports on various educational and vocational programs; information about inmates, including age, home county, birthplace, reason committed, education, and family situation; names of superintendents and officers; and financial statements. Later reports contain staff lists.

The 1926-1938 reports also include information on the Minnesota Home School for Girls in Sauk Centre.
