## SCOPE AND CONTENTS OF THE RECORDS

Maps, graphs, blueprints, and posters either created or used by the board in its coordination of federal, state, and local government agencies in a number of surveys and planning projects in the areas of land use, forest development, transportation, city planning, state finances and taxes, education, public health, recreation, and public welfare.

Topics covered in the records include soil classifications and conservation, precipitation, statewide air raid warning system, farm land and farm distribution, population distribution, schools, land use, the North Shore and Iron Range, nationality distribution, railroads and highways, 1909 Senate reapportionment, geology, income tax, economic regions, a state government organization chart (1938), the Grand Portage Indian Reservation (1921, 1930s), Fort Charlotte (1922), the Robert Street Bridge in St. Paul (1923), the Faribault House (1934), the Moorhead Training School (1907), Civil Works Administration districts (1934), Inter State Iron Company's Hill Annex Mine in Calumet (1937), the Red River trails (1938), Itasca State Park's Douglas Lodge (1939), and statewide hospital facilities (1943). There are also assorted maps and drawings of the cities of Cross Lake (undated), Mankato (1909), and Duluth (1934); Ramsey (1890), Mille Lacs (1934), and Itasca (1934) counties; and Fort Ridgely (undated, 1937).
