### ADMINISTRATIVE HISTORY OF THE COMMON MARKET PLAN

The Common Market Plan for the Minnesota State Colleges was proposed by Chancellor G. Theodore Mitau in 1968. Its philosophy was that the programs and resources of each of the six colleges in the state university system (Mankato, Moorhead, Winona, St. Cloud, Bemidji, and Southwest) would be available to students of all of the others.

As initially proposed and developed, the Common Market Plan focused on four programs: a system-wide internship program, student exchange, student teaching (urban clinical experience program), and a program called Community Resources in Higher Education. In the Internship Program a student would receive academic credit for one quarter of work experience in a public or private organization or business in his/her field of interest. In the Student Exchange Program, students could study from one to three quarters at the campus of another state university without having to transfer formally. The Urban Clinical Experience Program placed education majors in student teaching positions in school districts in the Minneapolis-St. Paul metropolitan area. In the Community Resources in Higher Education Program, the state colleges developed programs with community theaters, museums, and art and social service agencies.

#### SCOPE AND CONTENTS OF THE RECORDS

Correspondence, memoranda, plans, proposals, reports, background and publicity items, and related materials documenting the four primary programs of the board's Common Market Plan in their first several years of operation (1969-1973): the system-wide internship program, the student exchange program, the urban student teaching program, and the cooperative resource programs with community cultural and social service agencies. Also documented in these files are four programs funded by Common Market development grants, and "associated relationships" between the state colleges and other community organizations. They appear to be the files of Yvette Boe Oldendorf, coordinator/director of the Common Market Program.
