❖ Documents Produced using Legal Services

- In an average Legislative session, Legal Services produces:
 - **13,000 requests for Bill drafts**
 - **5800 Introduced Bills**
 - **26,000 drafts of amendments to Bills**
 - **11,700 Amended Bills**
 - **2700 Enrolled Bills**
 - **2700 Chaptered Bills**
- Legal Services is also used to index all introduced and amended versions of Bills. An index entry is created for every Law Section affected by a Legislative Bill.
- The Table of Sections Affected (TOSA) document or publication is created from these index entries. For 2007 we currently have 18,340 TOSA entries.
- 24 hour operations, with multiple shifts

Bill Document Print View

- The content of bills consists of actions taken upon code or law sections.
- TOSA entries are created automatically by parsing action lines.

CHAPTER 1111

An act to amend Section 100, repeal Section 105, and add Section 107 of the Evidence Code, relating to definitions and declaring the urgency thereof to take effect immediately.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 7, Lieu. Evidence: Definitions.

Existing law provides definitions of terms.

This bill would declare that it is to take effect immediately as an urgency statute.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 17070.40 of the Education Code is amended to read:

17070.40. (a) (1) A fund is hereby established in the State Treasury to be known as the 1998 State School Facilities Fund. All money in the fund, including any money deposited in that fund from any source whatsoever, and notwithstanding Section 13340 of the Government Code, is hereby continuously appropriated without regard to fiscal years for expenditure pursuant to this chapter.

(2) The board may apportion funds to school districts for the purposes of this chapter from funds transferred to the 1998 State School Facilities Fund from any source.

(3) The board may make apportionments in amounts not exceeding those funds on
