SUMMARY OF WORK: 1) conduct 4-8 Museum Lessons, Theater Programs (History Player(s), Game Show(s), Short Play(s)), History Live Lessons, and/or Outreach programs (History on the Move, Museum Lesson Outreach) and other specialized programs as assigned; 2) conduct object-based interpretive programs within the museum exhibits. (History a la Cart); 3) create a welcoming educational environment in the History Center exhibits by actively utilizing a variety of interpretive techniques and delivering strong customer service. ("Zone" work); 4) conduct exhibit-based programs for school-aged audiences. (Grainland); 5) participate in the planning and development of museum programs; and 6) assist in the daily operations of museum programs.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- High school diploma or equivalent.
- Current status as an Interpreter I at the History Center.
- Familiarity with History Center interpretive programs and exhibits, including satisfactory performance in at least 3 museum lessons, History Live lessons, and/or theater programs.
- Strong oral communications skills.
- Experience working with diverse audiences of varying cultural backgrounds, ages, and abilities.
- Demonstrated strength in providing consistent, quality customer service.
- Ability to maintain professionalism in demeanor and appearance.
- Ability to work cooperatively with team members.
- Ability to master and troubleshoot technological aspects of program delivery including audiovisual (AV)
 equipment and presentation software.
