located outside the metropolitan counties listed in section 473.121, subdivision 4, and outside the cities of

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Duluth, Mankato, Moorhead, Rochester, and St. Cloud, or an ambulance based in a community with a population of less than 1,000 persons.

advanced life support ambulance shall be staffed by at least:

        </paragraph>

          (2) one EMT and one registered nurse who is an EMT, is currently practicing nursing,
and has passed a paramedic practical skills test approved by the board and administered by a training program; or
