





Flour Tower



Ride a giant elevator though eight levels of the building and back in time. The dramatic use of lighting, sound, and special effects bring to life the powerful, noisy, and often dangerous process of transforming grain into flour.

Experience begins on Level 1 and exits on Level 8. Guests must stay seated throughout the show. Twelve minute continuous experience. Time-specific reservations required. English and Spanish captioning.

Observation Deck

Level 9 of Mill City Museum includes a glass-walled interior observation deck and a seasonal exterior observation deck to view Owámniyomni (St. Anthony Falls). These spaces can trigger a fear of heights for some guests.

Elevators

Mill City Museum includes three elevators.

Hydraulic Elevator Transports guests from the Mill Commons Lobby (Level

3) to the Rail Corridor, Education Lobby (Level 2), and

the Exhibit Gallery (Level 1).

Flour Tower Show begins on level 1 and ends on Level 8.

Glass Elevator Glass Elevator returns guest from Levels 8 & 9 to Level 1.

Guests who chose not to ride the Flour Tower may take elevator to Level 8 or Level 9 with staff assistance.
