









Quiet Rooms

Second Floor: Quiet space with soft seating.  
Third Floor: Parent's room with soft seating as well as children's  
books and toys.

Both rooms are available for all guests that need a quiet space but we ask that  
caregivers with young children be given priority access to the parent's room.  
The 2nd floor quiet room is the best space for wheel chair users.

3M Auditorium

Assistive listening devices are available for all programs in the 3M  
Auditorium. Wheelchair access through lower level. Ask a staff  
member for assistance.
